



Celtic Clothing

Materials: wool, linen, leather, skins, silk (imported)

Colours: bright! Main dyes: red (madder root), yellow (weld), blue (woad)

Patterns: checks, stripes, earthy colours

Items of clothing

Tunic: long shirt worn on upper body

Braecci: trousers often baggy

Skirt: from waist to ankles

Pouch: hangs on belt to carry personal items

Shoes: leather boots or wellingtons under trousers-no trainers!

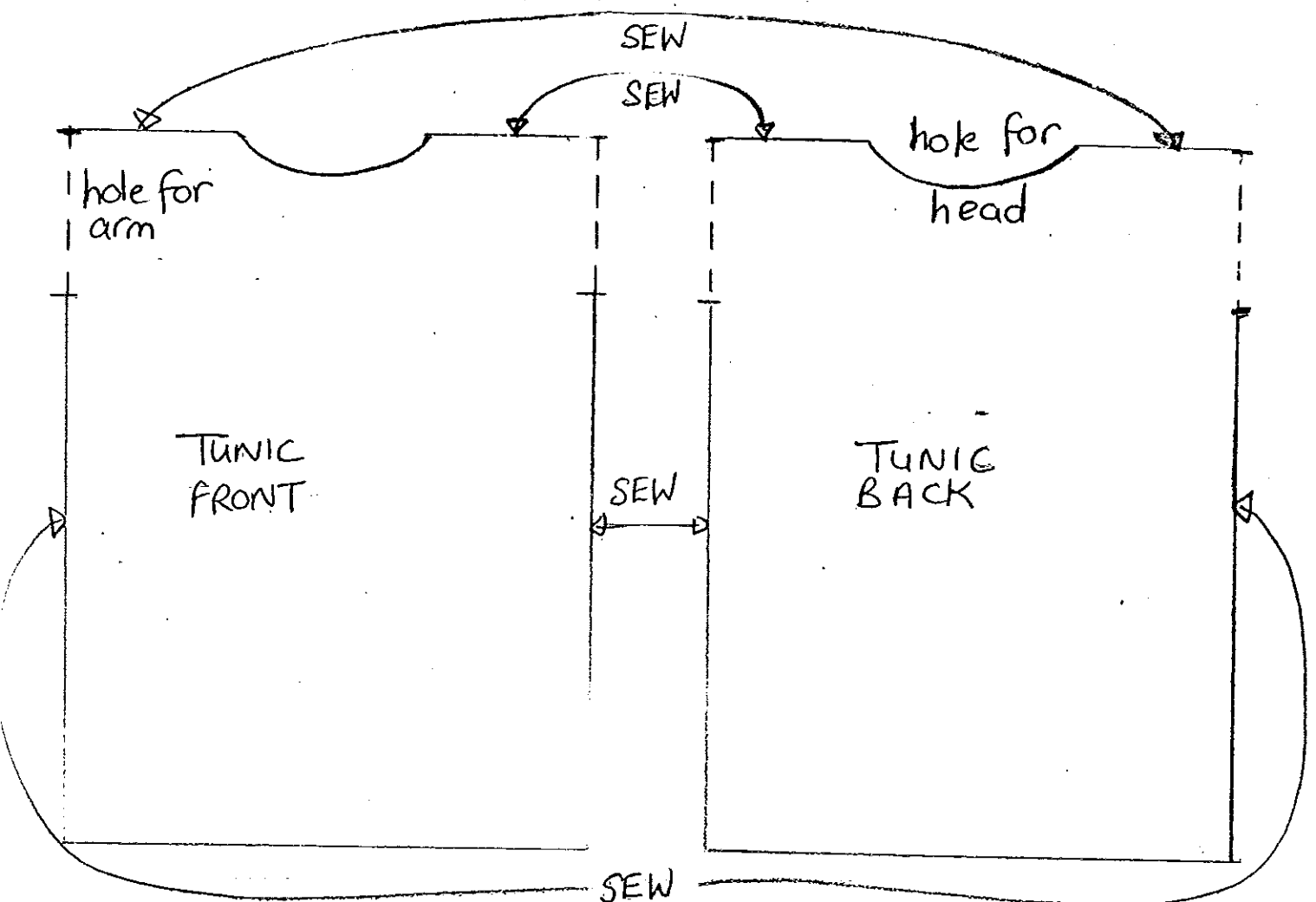
Cloak: large sheet of material or blanket draped around shoulders and pinned with a brooch

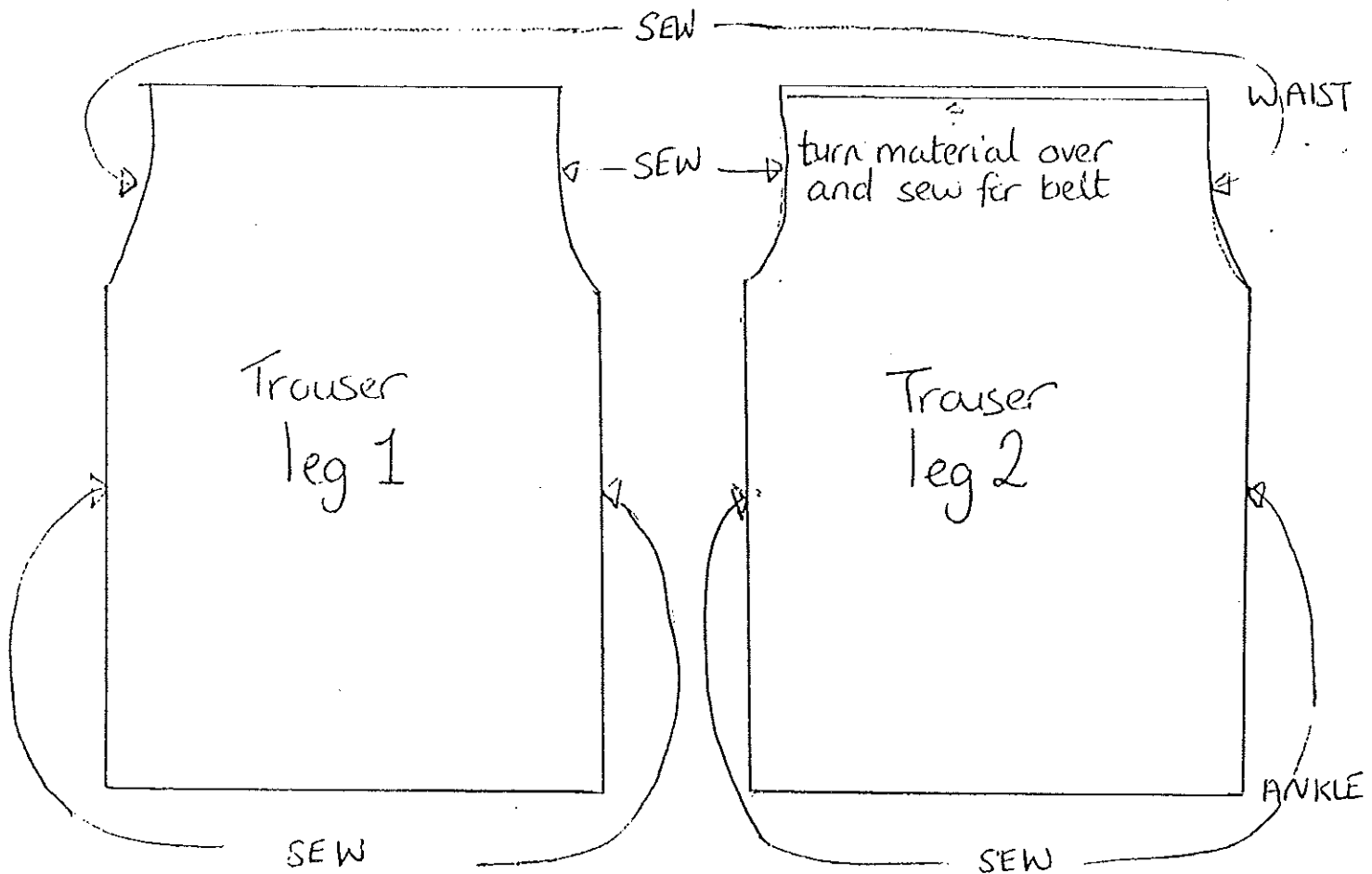
How to cheat

Tunic: use a man's collarless shirt, remove buttons and sew up to 6" from the top, roll up arms

Trousers: any checked or stripey trousers (not jeans!)

Wear jumper under tunic for warmth and bring a waterproof
