



Terms and Conditions

Celtic Harmony Camp is designed for visiting adults and children to have fun & enjoy learning ancient skills in a relaxed natural setting.

Events are organised and run by the Celtic Harmony team, however parents and families are expected to provide supervision, support and remain responsible for discipline of children at all times. If this supervision and help is not respected Celtic Harmony does not assume responsibility. All possible safety regulations are adhered to during a day at Celtic Harmony Camp, and risk assessments prepared for all activities.

Due to the outdoor nature of Celtic Harmony Camp and to meet Celtic Harmony H & S requirements, a minimum child / adult ratio of 5:1 is required or higher if stated on event information.

Please come dressed in outdoor clothes appropriate to the time of year.

Cancellation

In the event that you are unable to visit on your pre-booked date we will endeavour to reschedule your booking to a more convenient day. However, Less than 2 weeks prior to the visit date a cancellation fee of 50% total cost is payable.

Notification of cancellation must be sent in writing.

Hideaways & Hampers only
